

Christian Medical College PG Medical Entrance Exam - CMC PGMEE 2010

CMC Admission Test 2010 is due to be held on 21st February, 2010 (Sunday) from 2.00 PM to 4.30 PM at Chennai, New **Delhi** and Ludhiana.

CMC 2010 Eligibility Criteria

1. The candidate must be an Indian National.

2. A candidate who holds MBBS degree from CMC **medical college**

recognized by MCI. (or) a foreign **medical degree** included in the schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and who has obtained full CMC registration from the Medical Council of India. (or)

Any of the State Medical Councils after completing compulsory rotating internship shall be eligible for CMC admissions to Christian Medical College Ludhiana.

3. Candidates who have obtained their MBBS from colleges which are not recognized by Medical Council of India will not be granted CMC admission.

4. An Indian National who qualified from a Foreign **University** / School must produce an eligibility certificate recognizing the qualifying examination as equivalent to MBBS as recognized by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences and the Medical Council of India. 5. A candidate who after passing the final qualifying examination (MBBS or the Foreign Medical degree recognized by MCI) is undergoing 12 month compulsory internship / practical training and is likely to complete the same by 31 March, 2010 can take examination but he / she shall not be eligible for admission unless he / she has completed the compulsory rotating internship and obtained full registration on or before 31 March, 2010 (or) the candidate produces a certificate from the head of institution that he / she will be completing internship by 31 March, 2010.

6. No condonation of compulsory rotating internship shall be accepted unless approved by the medical council of India along with necessary proof of the approval of the Medical Council of India.

The condonation of compulsory rotating internship shall be restricted to the period up to 31 March, 2010 and not beyond that date.

7. The cut off dates for the recognition of the medical colleges for the year 2010 will be 31 October, 2009. The colleges recognized after this date will not be considered.

8. CMC Registration with the MCI / State Medical council is necessary and its documentary proof shall be furnished at the time of counselling.

9. Service Obligation: An applicant, who is expected to complete the service obligation in lieu of Sponsorship (for MBBS / PG **Diploma**) by 31 March, 2010, may apply.

A letter to this effect must be provided along with application, from the Principal of the concerned Medical College or authorized representative of the sponsoring body / Church or any other appropriate authority.

Applicant should have completed minimum 2 Years of service obligation by 31 March, 2010, allowing for adjustment of un-availed leave, if any.

CMC PGMEE 2010 Exam Scheme

An eligible applicant will be evaluated as per the schedule given below and the cumulative result will be the basis of CMC admission. The Total Marks will be 250.

A. CMC 2010 Admission Written Test (AWT) - Maximum 170 Marks

There will be only one Common Examination for Postgraduate diploma and degree courses, consisting of 170 multiple-choice questions from the MBBS syllabus, carrying one Mark each.

An applicant should secure a minimum of 50% Marks in the AWT to qualify for CMC oral examination. There is no negative Marking.

Important Notes:

* Candidates are advised not to bring their own pens to CMC Medical Entrance Examination Centre as the same will be provided by CMC Institute to each candidate before the commencement of CMC Entrance Examination.

* No candidate should carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any other material except CMC Admit Card (without envelope) inside the hall.

* If a candidate is found to be copying / conversing with other candidates / to have in his / her possession papers, notes or books, he / she shall be disqualified from taking CMC Entrance Examination and the next one or two such CMC Entrance Examinations according to the nature of offence and its intimation will be sent to the M.C.I., State M.C. and the concerned CMC Medical College for necessary action.

* Candidates shall maintain silence and attend to their papers only. Any disturbance in CMC Entrance Examination hall shall be deemed as misbehaviour and the candidate shall forfeit the right to continue to write in CMC Entrance Examination.

* The decision of the Centre Superintendent shall be final and conclusive. Do not carry cellular phones, pagers, calculators or any other electronic devices while coming to CMC Entrance Examination Centre; these are strictly prohibited in CMC Entrance Examination Centre.

B. CMC 2010 Oral Examination - Maximum 30 Marks

A Structured oral examination covering the clinical / practical aspects of the Surgical, Medical and Basic sciences subjects will be conducted for the candidates who qualify in CMC Admission Test 2010.

The list of candidates who qualify for CMC Oral Examination will be declared on 26 February, 2010 on the CMC Ludhiana notice board of the Office of the Registrar and www.cmcludhiana.org.

* If on verification, any certificates are found to be Inaccurate or false, CMC Form 99 will be Rejected.

* All Relevant Details to be filled in CMC Form 99 and Submitted alongwith Relevant Proof and CMC Ludhiana Application Form 2010. No Changes to CMC Form 99 will be Permitted after 21 February, 2010.

D. Preparation of CMC Final Merit List:

CMC Exam 2010 Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the following marks obtained by the applicant:

1. Written Test
2. CMC 2010 Oral Examination
3. Additional Marks, if any.

E. Tie-Breaking Rules:

In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal Marks in the competitive CMC Entrance Examination, their inter se merit will be determined in order of preference as under:

1. Marks in AWT.
2. Total percentage of Marks in MBBS.
3. Age of the candidate in favour of the older candidate.

F. Declaration of CMC 2010 Final Merit List:

CMC 2010 Merit list will be displayed on the notice board of the office of the Registrar, Christian Medical College Ludhiana on 16 March, 2010 and subsequently on CMC website: www.cmcludhiana.org. No separate information regarding result will be sent to the candidates.

CMC PGMEE 2010 Reservetion Seats

Allotment of Seats by Personal Appearance (CMC 2010 Counseling):

CMC 2010 Admissions to PG Courses are based purely on merit:

The allotment of seats shall be made to the candidates through personal appearance. For personal appearance the candidates will be called in order of merit.

CMC PG 2010 Counseling will be held on 18 March, 2010 from 09.00 AM onwards in Christian Medical College Ludhiana.

All candidates desirous of CMC admission and having appeared for the AWT and CMC Oral Examination are to appear personally for CMC counseling.

The candidates will be called as per category and merit / rank. The candidates appearing for allotment by personal appearance should bring the following documents in original.

Candidates without original documents shall not be allowed to participate in CMC counseling. Candidates should keep a Photocopy of certificates submitted, in their possession.

1. CMC Admit card.
2. High School / Higher Secondary Certificate as proof of date of birth.
3. All MBBS university professional examination Marks certificates.
4. MBBS degree / provisional certificate.
5. Internship completion certificate.
6. Valid permanent / provisional registration certificate issued by MCI / state medical council.
7. Sponsorship / service obligation completion certificate (if applicable).
8. Certificate from MS / Principal regarding satisfactory service in Christian Medical College Ludhiana after service obligation / without service obligation.
9. Migration certificate for applicants who are graduates from universities other than Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot website: www.babafariduniv.com.
10. 3 Stamp size photographs.
11. Any other certificate relevant for CMC admissions.
12. Church membership, Baptism certificate (for Christian Applicants only).
13. Sponsorship letter from sponsoring body / church-for sponsored candidates.

The number of seats available in each category and in each subject will be displayed and updated as the counseling proceeds. The primary list will also be available on www.cmcludhiana.org.

The candidates will have the right to choose any one of the available seats at his / her rank and the same will be allotted to him / her.

The mere fact that a candidate has appeared for allotment on the notified date does not mean that the allotment will be made to him / her, as the same will depend upon the availability of seat at his / her rank and the choices exercised by the candidate.

Allotment letter and CMC admission letter will be granted on the same day of CMC counseling to the candidate.

A candidate desirous of participating in subsequent counselling (2nd or 3rd) after taking CMC admission in any P.G. Course shall first have to vacate present course seat (as per rules) and let that seat be put up for counselling too.

In the matter of allocation / CMC admission of candidates to respective subjects and courses the decision of PG selection committee of Christian Medical College Ludhiana shall be final.

Following CMC admission, the Staff & Students Health Services of Christian Medical College Ludhiana, will examine all the candidates.

A candidate will not be allowed to continue his / her **studies** in the college if found medically unfit.

Immunization against Hepatitis-B: All admitted candidates have to get immunized against Hepatitis-B within the first week of admission at their own expense.

Following CMC Ludhiana 2010 admission, a candidate should register with Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot within the limit permitted by University, through the Principal of CMC College.

All CMC 2010 Admissions are Provisional Subject to the Approval & Confirmation of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences and Medical Council of India.

In compliance to MCI time schedule for various courses, No CMC admissions will be made to CMC Medical College after 31st May, 2010 for the session starting April, 2010.

Submission of CMC Application Form 2010:

A completed CMC 2010 Application for Post **Graduate Program** consists of:

1. CMC Application Form completely filled with a photograph attached and signed by the applicant with half signature on the Photograph and half on CMC 2010 Application Form.
2. Two passport size photographs stapled to CMC 2010 Application Form with name written on the back of the Photograph. The candidate should be recognizable by the photograph and any change in face structure due to change in hair style and beard style etc may be a reason for the invigilator to refuse the applicant's entry into CMC Entrance Examination hall. Such case will be the sole responsibility of the candidate.

3. CMC 2010 Admit card with Photograph and address filled in correctly.

4. CMC 2010 Form 99 - Filled,

* Leave the spaces marked as official use only.

* It is the responsibility of the candidate to enclose photocopies of all relevant documents as per requirement for 'Additional Marks' to be considered for Marks applied for in CMC Form 99.

5. High School / Higher Secondary certificate as proof of date of birth.

6. All MBBS University Professional examination Marks certificates.

7. Church membership certificate, Baptism certificate (for Christian candidates).

8. Sponsorship Letter for PG Course (for category A).

9. Sponsorship / Service Obligation completion certificate / No Objection Certificate from the relevant authority, as applicable.

10. CMC 2010 Application fee - A bank demand draft for Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) drawn in favour of "Christian Medical College Ludhiana Society" on any scheduled bank payable at Ludhiana. If form has been downloaded from CMC website Rs.3100/- has to be submitted.
